Rio was the 2005 USEF Leading Living Sire of Hunters in North America & is arguably the best H/J sire in Canadian history. His versatile offspring include "Catwalk", winner of two Show Jumping WC qualifiers in 2007, Intermediate Eventing Champion "R Kameo" and USEF FEI 6 year old Dressage winner "Grande Crimson" as well as many approved stallions and numerous premium mares. Rio Grande sired many of the very best Hunters currently showing in the US, including Winter Equestrian Festival Champions Rio Renoir, Rio Bravo, Rave, Eye Remember Rio and Due North as well as 2002 AHSA Horse of the Year Rio Bronco.

Rio Grande was the winner of his stallion performance test and an International Show Jumper successfully representing Team Canada at Nations Cup competitions on several occasions. Rio Grande was one of a few stallions that truly put a stamp on his offspring, passing on his good looks, outstanding athletic abilities, versatility and wonderful temperament.

We consider **Viva Voltaire**, sire of several Young Horse Champions and numerous exceptional prospects for the dressage, hunter and jumper ring, our best kept secret.

Viva's extraordinary jumping pedigree combines the famous bloodlines of Voltaire, Grannus & Argentinus. Viva has proven himself in the jumper ring, winning the Ontario Championship and the Canadian Reserve Championship as a four and five year old respectively.

We have found our Viva offspring to be extremely marketable, especially as dressage and hunter prospects. Viva Voltaire typically produces stunningly beautiful, flashy foals, with excellent gaits, lots of jump and the most wonderful temperament.

During his first year of breeding, Viva Voltaire produced outstanding horses for the dressage and hunter ring. The stallion Viva's Salieri won several dressage Championships. Highlights include his win of the FEI 5 year old class at the prestigious "Dressage at Devon" with a dream score of 81.6% and the North American breeders title.

Vivaldi and Viva's Primus claimed numerous Hunter Championships in the US and established their young sire on the USEF Hunter Sire ranking. Several "Vivas" have won young horse jumper classes.

Futurist passed his 100 day performance test with an excellent score of 127 points. He is a son of two time Olympic Champion "For Pleasure". Futurist exemplifies the modern type sport horse and passes on this athleticism, rideability and wonderful gaits.

Cabardino - a stallion who combines scope, technique, temperament, beauty and outstanding athleticism in one complete package. Cabardino has won countless 4' Regular Hunter Championships in the US and Canada. Highlights include Cabardino's win of the Canadian Championship at the Royal in 2007 & the Reserve Championship in 2008 as well as the Regular Hunter Championship at the prestigious Winter Equestrian Festival in Wellington, Florida. Cabardino won several Grand Hunter titles both in the US and Canada including the 2008 Royal Winter Fair Grand Champion Amateur trophy. Cabardino was Reserve Champion at the Oldenburg International Stallion Approval for Show Jumpers. He passed the 30 day test in Germany and qualified for the Bundeschampionat with an extraordinary jumping score of 9. Cabardino sired an approved breeding stallion during his first year of breeding in Germany. He is known to produce beautiful, tall, very flashy and athletic foals with outstanding movement & he passes on his extraordinary technique over jumps. Cabardino has produced numerous premium and several Champion foals during his first two years of breeding in North America. His son Caballero, who is being presented this week, is without any doubt one of the best Hunter prospects ever born at our farm. Cabardino's temperament is second to none and his scope and technique over jumps is simply extraordinary.

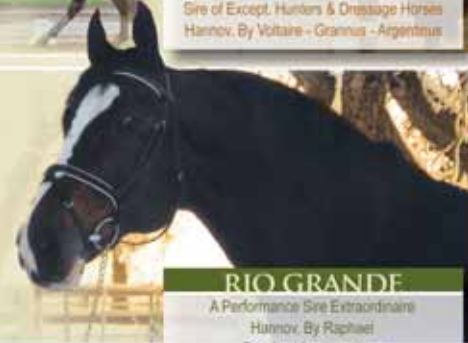
